BRIEF HISTORY OF THARAKA UNIVERSITY

On 12th June, 2015 Njuri Ncheke Elders (the Supreme Council of Ameru Elders) and Professionals of the Greater Meru Region requested His Excellency the President to assist in establishing a University in Tharaka. He accepted and instructed Chuka University to work closely with Ministry of Education Science and Technology (MoEST) to establish a Campus that would be elevated to the status of a fully-fledged University within two years. The Ministry of Education Science and Technology wrote to Chuka University on 14th July, 2015 to implement the directive of the President on establishing a Campus in Tharaka.

Chuka University established Tharaka Campus in September, 2015. The community organizeda fundraising on 5th March, 2016 to set initial infrastructure and raised KShs 3.6 million. On 8th February, 2017, a Consultative meeting was held to discuss the upgrading of Tharaka Campus 2nd Graduation Ceremony

into a University College. With the support from Office of the President, establishment of the Tharaka University College was realized. On 23rd March, 2017, the Campus was inspected by Commission for University Education (CUE) and was later gazetted on 27th July 2017 as a Constituent College of Chuka University through the Tharaka University College Legal Notice No. 146 of 2017. On the 2nd of August, 2022, the University College was awarded a charter by His Excellency the former President of the Republic of Kenya Hon. Uhuru Muigai Kenyatta at a ceremony held at Kakamega State Lodge in Kakamega County. The University achieved the status of a fully-fledged University.

Since its inception, Tharaka University has continued to enjoy unprecedented growth in student and staff population, as well as academic, research and outreach activities. The University has identified its niche area in **Dryland Farming**, **Mining and minerology**. The knowledge of dryland farming is expected to significantly contribute to the improvement of the livelihoods of the communities living in Arid and Semi-Arid Lands (ASALs). The University endeavors to create a strong knowledge-base, conduct research and outreach actives on mining and minerology for societal transformation.
